Swift Dog Sports - Safety protocols during COVID-19



Swift Dog Sports is committed to the safety of our clients, our family and our community and will work within the orders and recommendations of our Provincial Health Officer. The following COVID-19. This safety plan will be implemented as part of my preventative measures until further notice. This plan is subject to change and will be updated based on any new recommendations from the Provincial Health Officer.

<u>Pre-screening measures:</u> Before the start of any teaching session, all participants, including instructors, must disclose if they have experienced ANY of the following:

- Fever, dry cough, difficulty breathing, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, headache, muscle aches, fatigue, vomiting or diarrhea for more than 24 hours
- Have travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days.
- Have come into contact with a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last 14 days. Clients will be reminded by email often to self-screen for these risk factors before our session

Postponing due to illness: If you answer "yes" to any of the pre-screening questions, you must contact me ASAP to reschedule your session. I also ask that clients advise me if they become ill up to 14 days after their training session.

Group Class Safety:

- A limit of 1 handler per dog for each class will be set.
- Handlers and instructors will maintain a social distance of 6 feet from each other at all times.
- •Handlers and instructors will wear masks if they're unable to stay within 6 feet from each other
- Hand sanitizer will be available at all times
- Gloves will be available at all times
- All equipment and gear will be sanitized frequently (chairs,doorknobs,equipment,high touch surfaces)
- * Any equipment that cannot be easily disinfected between classes will be put in a labeled bin for disinfecting at the end of the night.
- The door will remain open to provide ventilation.
- Classes will have separate entrances and staggered start times so students are easily spread out when exiting and entering for classes.
- Doorways will have hand sanitizer available for students to use upon on entry and exit of the facility.

- Seats for students will be 10 feet apart to maintain physical distancing.
- Students must bring their own clickers, targets, water dishes and treat pouches.
- \bullet Instructors will be the only ones to touch equipment unless students sanitize before and after or wear gloves provided.
